

Legal Regulation of Notary's Activity in Ukraine:

Ukraine notary legislation of the XIX - XXI centuries*

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The book presents the full text of the Law of Ukraine, "On Notariate." The author analyzes and provides a general description of the provisions of the legislation that regulated notarial activities and operated in the Ukrainian lands during the XIX - XXI centuries. These provisions show the transformation of the legal status of a notary from a civil servant (as a court employee) to an independent person representing and acting on behalf of the State but cannot exercise power.

The publication is intended for notaries, employees of the notarial bodies, lawyers, jurists, scientists, university professors, and law students of higher education institutions and can be helpful to a wide range of people interested in studying the legislation of Ukraine on notarial.
